

EDUCATION CASE STUDY

SUMMIT COUNTRY DAY SCHOOL - CINCINNATI, OH





PROGRAM REQUIREMENT

A major snowstrom collapsed the roof of Summit Country Day School resulting in several displaced students. Administrators needed to find an immediate space solution for the three third grade classrooms that no longer had a home. Satellite Shelters completed this project within two weeks as requested, while working in near zero degree weather.

DESIGN SOLUTION

The Satellite construction and design team developed a plan in concert with educators and city officials to expedite the delivery and construction of a temporary facility that would be ready for occupancy in ten days after the roof collapse. By joining three, double wide modules, faculty and students enjoyed classrooms that provided the flexibility and natural light that was missing from their previous building. Teachers even had the opportunity to request special classroom modifications to minimize the temporary feel of the buildings.

BUILDING FEATURES

- Three 24' x 60' double wide classrooms
- Large windows created a bright and airy learning environment
- Wood paneled exterior, skirting and two 70-foot long decks minimized the temporary nature of the buildings
- Simplified utility hookup design reduced cost and expedited project completion
